Non-Discriminatory Services offered to the public:

Community Protection: Surveillance and follow-up of all communicable diseases

Tuberculosis Program: Offering TB skin testing, follow-up, and referral of individuals with positive tests

Environmental Services: Inspection of day care facilities, schools, restaurants, caterers, taverns, temporary food stands, grocery stores, truck wrecks, lodging facilities, and private water supplies. Investigate environmental complaints and violations of wastewater and sewage. Issue permits and perform inspections on new or updated onsite wastewater systems. Assist with communicable disease control involving food or water-borne illnesses. Provide education for food handlers and day care providers.

Maternal Child Health (MCH): Offers services to ensure the health and well being of Cole County citizens with special emphasis women of childbearing age, teens and children. Women of childbearing age are encouraged to enter prenatal care by their 13th week of pregnancy. Teens and adults are educated in the early recognition and prevention of teen suicide. Citizens of Cole County are educated in lead poisoning prevention and treatment.

Childcare Health Consultation (CCHC): Is a free service to provide health and safety education to promote optimal health and safety. Free clock hours for providers on topics related to the health and safety of the children they care for are available. Health

promotion classes, that are age appropriate, are provided to children in childcare settings. Health education to care providers and parents are also provided.

Dental, Eye and Shoe Program: Services available to school age children. Contact child's school nurse for further information, or Rachelle Collinge, RN, BSN

Office Visits: Available to the public Monday – Friday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm for Blood pressure screening, Pregnancy testing, Adolescent/Adult immunizations, TB skin testing.

Vital Records: Local registrar for Cole and Osage County birth and death certificates

Adult Head Injury Program: Special health care needs: For persons 21 years and older with a traumatic brain injury (TBI). Provides assistance to identify and access medical, rehabilitation, and social services.

HIV/AIDS Case Management: Provides assistance in locating, coordinating, and purchasing medical and psychosocial services for individuals with HIV or AIDS.

Bio-Terrorism Regional Planner: Develops and updates preparedness and response plans concerning public health emergencies for Cole, Camden, Morgan, Miller and Moniteau counties.

Regional Epidemiology Specialist: Provides technical support in the prevention of and response to communicable disease outbreaks encompassing the region of Cole, Osage-Gasconade, and Moniteau counties.

Pregnancy testing: For women who are at least two weeks late for their menses. There is a fee charged for this test. The fee can be billed to Medicaid for those clients with Medicaid benefits. For clients with positive results, and no insurance, Temporary Medicaid forms can be provided. The fee for the test will not be billed to temporary Medicaid.

Tuberculosis skin testing: For anyone able to return in 48 -72 hours to have this test evaluated. There is a fee charged for this test. For clients with Medicaid, this fess can be billed to Medicaid.

Services Offered to the public:

Prenatal care by a Family Nurse Practitioner, under a collaborative practice agreement with local Obstetricians in Jefferson City, to any pregnant woman with Temporary, Straight, or Missouri Care Medicaid, wishing to do all of their prenatal care at Cole County Health Department. Our collaborative practice agreement is with OB-GYN and Associates for delivery at Capital Region Medical Center (CRMC) only. All required and/or recommended laboratory testing will be done at CRMC. Ultrasounds that are medically necessary will be scheduled at CRMC. Delivery will be done at CRMC by the on-call Obstetrician in practice at OB-GYN & Associates.

Eligibility guidelines:

The pregnant woman must qualify for Medicaid for pregnant women (MPW). Medicaid for pregnant women is a MC+ program for citizens who are pregnant. Non-citizens do not qualify for MC+, however, there is another program called Temporary Medicaid. Non-citizens must still meet the eligibility guidelines established by the Family Support Division (FSD) in the county in which they reside. All eligible women should make application for MPW at the FSD in the county in which they reside. There are three (3) MC+ plans available in central Missouri.
